Accessing the Train Domain

1. Open your internet browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Chrome) and enter or type the following URL into the address bar: <https://paloca.cernerworks.com/Citrix/T163aWeb/>
2. Log in with your Palomar Health academic credentials - Username: ID#; Password (fig. 1)

NOTE: If this is your first time logging in, enter #PalomarLast4ofSSN (i.e. #Palomar1234) within the password field. This is a temporary password and it will prompt you to change your password.

3. Determine whether you already have the Citrix Receiver application installed on your PC.
 - a. If you have the Citrix Receiver installed, skip to **step 4**.
 - b. If you do not have the Citrix Receiver installed, click on **Download Receiver for Windows** at the very bottom left of your window.
 - c. Click on the **CitrixReceiver.exe** file that will appear at the bottom of your window. See example screen shots below for Chrome (fig. 2) and Internet Explorer (fig. 3).
 - d. The Citrix Receiver Set-up will open when the download is complete.

- e. You may get a pop-up asking if you would like this program to make changes to your computer. Select **Allow**. (Please note that this pop-up varies by browser.)
- f. In the Citrix Receiver Setup Window, click on **Install** (fig. 4).

- g. Click on **Finish** when you receive the “Installed Successfully” window (fig. 4.1). You do not need to add an account.

4. Return to the *Cerner Works applications* screen in your open internet browser window.
5. Click the **PowerChart T163 Anon** icon.
6. Depending on your internet browser, PowerChart may first drop into a launch bar or request confirmation to launch. See example screen shots below for Chrome (fig. 5) and Internet Explorer (fig. 6).
